

Cricket Cleaning

It is good practice to ensure your Cricket I or Cricket II is clean, dry and in working order before every use. Regular checks highlight any dirt, damage or wear that can affect the Crickets' use and function.

Component	Cleaning procedure
Full Cricket	Visually inspect the whole unit checking for any signs of damage or missing parts and that paint work is intact.
Knee Pad	Ensure the knee pad is securely fitted to the frame and the cover is clean and free from rips/tears. Wipe the knee pad cover with a cloth, dampened with warm water and a mild detergent as required; ensuring it is completely dry before use.
Seat	Check the seat is fitted correctly and can be hooked securely onto the opposing bar. Look for any signs of damage or wear in the stitching, fabric or hook fixture. Wipe the seat with a cloth, dampened with warm water and a mild detergent as required; ensure the seat is completely dry before use. If necessary, the seat can be removed and machine washed at 40° using a biological cleaner.
Foot rest	The Foot rest should be clear of any debris and the textured footprints should be intact to aid location and grip. Check the foot rest for any cracks or damage. It can be wiped down with a damp cloth as required
Frame	Check the frame for any damage, wear or dirt. Ensure the height clamps are equal and secure. Clean the frame with a cloth, dampened with warm water and a mild detergent as required; ensuring it is completely dry before use.
Chrome parts	The back bars and pads should be clean, easily rotated and free from damage. Wipe with a dry cloth to remove any dirt or marks.
Castors	Make sure the castors are free from fluff or thread and can spin freely. Each brake should be checked by applying and releasing the foot catch accordingly
Labels	The seat labels should be clean and intact to indicate the back of the seat. The serial number label is located on the base frame, which should be intact, visible and legible.
